## **Objective**

SGS Japan Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "SGS") was commissioned by Lion Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "the Organization") to conduct independent verification based on Criteria of Verification (ISO14064-3: 2019 and the SGS verification protocol) regarding the data prepared by the Organization on the scope of verification (hereinafter referred to as "the statement"). The objective of this verification is to confirm that the statement in the Organization's applicable scope has been correctly calculated and reported in the statement in conformance with the criteria, and to express our views as a third party. The Organization is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the statement.

### Scope

The scope of verification is Scope 1 and 2 emissions, Scope3 emissions, energy consumption, water usage (water withdrawal) and discharge, and COD emissions.

The period subject to report is from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022.

Refer to the attached sheet for the detailed scope of verification and the period subject to report.

#### **Procedure of Verification**

The statement was verified in accordance with Criteria of Verification, and the following processes were implemented at a limited level of assurance:

- Verification of the calculation system: Interviews on the measurement, tabulation, calculation and reporting
  methods employed by the Organization as well as review of related documents and records
- Verification of the statement: On-site verification and review of vouchers conducted at Lion Chemical Co.,
   Ltd Fine Chemical Division and Lion Specialty Chemicals Co.,
   Ltd Ono Plant, and analytical procedures and interviews for the other sites in the scope of verification carried out at the Organization's Headquarters

The criteria for this review are based on, Act on the Rational Use of Energy, Act on the Rational Use and Proper Management of Fluorocarbons, GHG Emissions Calculation and Reporting Manual Ver. 4.8 and the protocol specified by the Organization.

### Conclusion

Within the scope of the verification activities employing the methodologies mentioned above, nothing has come to our attention that caused us to believe that the Organization's Statement was not calculated and reported in conformance with the criteria.

SGS Japan Inc. affirms our independence from the Organization, being free from bias and conflicts of interest with the Organization.
